The presentation will include an audio/video talk and a fly tying demonstration on tying the jig fly for panfish and bass.

Anthony has been a proud member of NGFF since 1991. He served as the President of FFF-SEC 2009-12. He is recognized nationally for his spun deer-hair bass flies, smallmouth bass nymphs (the Hellcraw), saltwater streamers and especially his unique soft-bodied foam poppers, divers and sliders. He has authored five articles published in *Fly Tyer Magazine* and was the subject of an article published by Bruce Ingram in the May 2012 issue of *Wildlife in North Carolina Magazine*. Anthony served as a consultant and contributing author to Bob Clouser’s outstanding book, “Fly Fishing for Smallmouth in Rivers and Streams”. Anthony is a Dr. Slick Company Pro Consultant. Anthony’s greatest fishing achievement was to land Robin (Greene) Hipps as his wife for the last 22 years.
