* We received the following notice from Jake Rash w/ NCWRC regarding trout stocking

NCWRC has been forced to reduce the number of trout stocked in all waters by 50% through August 2014. This reduction is primarily the result of great blue heron predation on trout at Setzer State Fish Hatchery. As noted below, all raceways have been covered and a deterrent system (sonic and light) has been installed to prevent future predation. Additionally, we are working with other state, federal, and private hatcheries to obtain fish in an effort to reduce the impact of the fish loss. It is important to note that we expect stockings for Delayed Harvest Trout Waters in October to be back to normal and continue as such moving forward.
