

Nat Greene Fly Fishers Meeting

If you ever wondered where to fish for trout in North Carolina you must come to [Nat Greene Fly Fishers](#) meeting on June 11th. Our speaker will be fly fisherman Bobby Kilby a native of western NC who now resides in Pawley's Island, SC. Bobby challenged himself to fish every trout stream in NC. In order to count the stream he caught at least two trout, and 99.999999% were on a dry fly; his current count is 1,204 streams. Bobby's detailed fishing journal has been used by biologist with the NC Wildlife Commission. He also co-authored the

Western NC Fly Fishing Trail Map.

The trove of information recorded in Bobby's journal is not available to the public, so your only chance to glean some information is to come hear him speak at Nat Greene Fly Fishers meeting at [Leonard Recreation Center](#) **6324 Ballinger Rd., Greensboro, NC at 7pm.**
