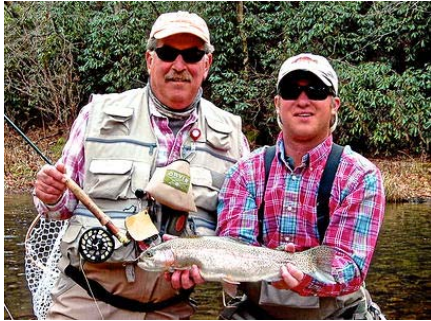


NAT GREENE FLY FISHERS NEWSLETTER

The Guy's at Due South Outfitters <http://www.duesouthoutfitters.com/> who were kind enough to donate a float trip to our banquet will be speaking at our March 12th meeting. They plan to discuss deep nymphing tailraces (as in waters deeper than 10 feet) as well as fishing the tributaries of larger rivers. The South Holston and Watauga offer great fishing, but the small tributaries that feed those streams offer great fishing during the spawning seasons and warmer months. They have developed a method of deep nymphing via sliding rigs so it should be pretty interesting.



Nick Garrett and Patrick Sessoms North Carolina natives founded Due South Outfitters. They met at Appalachian State

and both have attended the Sweet Water Guide School in Montana. While in Montana the concept of Due South Outfitters developed.
