The March meeting will feature Bill Wilkerson who will discuss Early Trip Planning for the Upcoming Fishing Season. Bill will focus on three destinations you may have thought were out of your reach. He will discuss the opportune time for planning and equipment needed to be successful while fishing for Alaska Salmon and Trout, early fall NC false albacore, and late fall British Columbia steelhead and trout. All of his information is derived from personal experience, so bring a pencil and pad so you can start planning for your next big destination.
