Matt is known for putting you on the hottest action in Virginia whether it is musky, smallmouth, striped bass, or trout. Matt guided 6 years in Colorado, then moved back home to Lynchburg, VA to guide his home waters. He will cover fishing the James, New, Staunton/Roanoke, and Jackson rivers.

June 9th, Tuesday @ 7pm Leonard Recreation Center Richard Griggs with Carolina Mountain Sports will talk about Contradictions in Fly Fishing - Secrets for Success). Richard will talk about fishing upstream vs. fishing downstream; casting vs. no casting; active retrieves vs. dead drift.

While discussing these options, he'll also look at some tips and pointers that seem to increase success: use of split shot; improving your roll cast; using strike indicators; selecting your fly line; expediting your learning curve; and knots and knot sense (which may be something like nonsense).

Richard is a longtime supporter of our club, donating many nice banquet items every year. He has been a popular speaker at other clubs, and we are lucky to get him as a speaker. Please come and pick up techniques and suggestions to catch more fish.
